Top, bottom, left and right margins should be 1" and the abstract prepared for printing on standard letter (8.5 in. x 11 in.). We can only accept PDF format for the electronic submissions. Abstracts submitted in any other format will not be printed in the extended abstract book.

Please indicate whether this is an invited or contributed abstract for the conference. All contributed abstracts will be considered for oral presentations. Those that are not selected for oral presentations should prepare a poster. If you do not wish the abstract to be considered for an oral presentation please indicate poster. All participants are encouraged to submit an abstract for a poster.

Be advised that we highly recommend including high quality color figures in your abstract. However, whereas the electronic version of the abstract book (available online preceding the conference) will represent the color of the figures as submitted, the printed version of the abstract book will in grayscale. Thus, please plan accordingly when making your color selections for figures.
