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Courses

- I certify that I am a Virginia resident, at least 60 years of age, therefore, I am eligible to take as many as three courses for audit or zero value credit under the Senior Citizens Higher Education Act.
- I certify that I am a Virginia resident, at least 60 years of age and that my taxable income for Virginia income tax purposes was no more than \$10,000 last year, therefore, I am eligible to take courses for credit under the Senior Citizens Higher Education Act.

The Senior Citizens Higher Education Act provides that any legal resident of the state who, before the beginning of any semester ... in which he/she claims benefits of the Act, and who has had his/her legal domicile in the state for one year and is 60 years or older, may without paying tuition:

- Register for and enroll in courses for academic credit if he/she had a taxable income not exceeding \$10,000 for Virginia income tax purposes for the preceeding year in which enrollment is sought.
- Register for and audit no more than three courses offered for academic credit.
- Register for and enroll in no more than three courses not offered for academic credit.

The tuition-free policy shall apply except that the Senior Citizen shall be subject to the cost of private music lessons and paying for special course and materials fees, such as textbooks, laboratory and art fees. The Senior Citizen must be classified as an in-state student by the university, thus, an Application for Virginia In-state Rates must be on file with the university.

The senior citizen shall be subject to admission requirements of the institution and shall be admitted to a course after all tuition-paying students have been accommodated. The institution shall determine whether or not it has the ability to offer the course(s).



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
