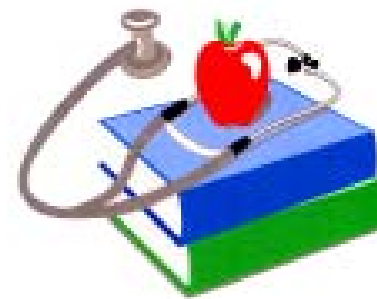

Disaster Preparedness for School Nurses

This full day workshop has been developed by the National Association of School Nurses (NASN). School nurses will be provided with knowledge and skills to prepare for and respond to a school disaster.

Following the workshop, school nurses will be able to:

- ▣ Define terms common to disaster preparedness.
- ▣ Describe the school nurse's role in planning a disaster response and mitigating the school environment.
- ▣ Discuss activation and response procedures.
- ▣ Demonstrate appropriate triage of adults and children.
- ▣ Describe actions associated with short and long-term recovery within the context of community resources.
- ▣ Describe adult, child, and responder reactions to stress and interventions to deal with the stress response.
- ▣ Identify and respond to diseases which may result from biologic, chemical and radiological terrorism.
