

Mentoring for Richmond Class 2009

In the effort to make mentoring for the PBS Facilitator project more efficient, cost effective, and structured, standard process students in the Richmond PBS Class of 2009 will be assigned to mentoring groups that will meet on a regularly scheduled monthly basis. The groups will provide students with the majority of their 24 required mentoring hours. The remaining hours can be obtained through traditional individual mentoring time.

Students will be divided into groups of 4 or 5 based on the geographic location or self-selection. The groups will have a mentor from that area assigned to them. They will meet once a month for 2 to 3 hours per session. The mentor will set the meetings based on the schedules of all involved. The tentative schedule of the mentoring groups is below.

Group mentoring meeting #1 (to take place after PBS class session #3):

Topics: finding focus persons and getting together teams, person centered planning (PCP) work, general updates

Group mentoring meeting #2 (to take place after PBS class session #4):

Topics: updates on PCP, teams and focus persons, discuss behavioral terminology, beginning of functional behavior assessment (FBA) - identifying behaviors, collecting baseline data

Group mentoring meeting #3 (to take place after PBS class session #5):

Topics: updates on PCP (students should at least have person picked and team meetings by now), FBA continues- show data, discuss PBS aspects

Group mentoring meeting #4 (to take place after PBS class session #6):

Topics: updates on PCP (should be completed or close to), present PCP to group, PBS plan discussion- hypotheses, hypotheses testing, case status

Group mentoring meeting #5 (to take place after PBS class session #7):

Topics: PCP updates and more presentations, FBA complete or close to completion, case updates, hypotheses testing, intervention planning, data graphs

Group mentoring meeting #6 (to take place after PBS session #8):

Topics: PBS plan updates, PBS plan presentations, data graphs, intervention outcomes, portfolio assembly

Group mentoring meeting #7:

Topics: PBS plans presented, portfolio assembly, check/review all of portfolio requirements
