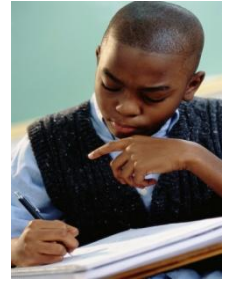

Proficiency in Sentence Writing Strategy

This workshop provides teachers with the strategy to assist students in learning to write four types of sentences: simple, compound, complex, and compound-complex. This strategy was developed at the University of Kansas Center for Research on Learning. Research results demonstrated that students wrote complete sentences an average of 65% of the time on the pretest and an average of 88% of the time on the posttest.

Fundamentals in the Sentence Writing Strategy

Following the first part of the workshop, teachers will walk away with another strategy developed at the University of Kansas Center for Research on Learning. This strategy is intended for students who struggle to learn the four types of sentences presented in the Proficiency in the Sentence Writing Strategy. It teaches students how to master write just simple sentences using an easy, 4-step approach.
